A. Before use

- 1. Before using the safety pen needle, consult its instructions for use
- 2. Before use, take care not to activate the safety mechanism accidentally, as the safety Pen needle cannot be used any more

B. How to operate


- 1. Clean the rubber seal on the pen with an alcohol swab.
- 2. Take the sterile paper off from the SureComfort.




3. Holding the sterile cap, push and twist the pen needle straight onto the pen in a clockwise direction until it meets resistance with crunching sound



4. Remove the sterile cap from pen needle



5. Check cannula to see if it's damaged (bent, broken, etc.). Venting the pen: Set 1-2 insulin units and allow 1-2 drops to flow out of the pen needle



6. Dial the prescribed dosage on the pen



7. Pull the skin tight and insert the pen needle straight into the skin at an angle of 90° until the middle cap touches the skin and the "click" sound is audible.



8. Inject insulin according to instructions for use of the insulin pen. Leave the insulin pen in the skin for 10 seconds after injection.




9. Remove safety pen needle from skin. The safety mechanism is released automatically



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10. After injection twist the insulin pen counterclockwise to remover the pen needle from



[Cautions for use]

A. Warnings

- 1. Do not use the safety pen needle if:
- the sterile cap or sterile paper is damaged.
- the sterile paper is detached.
- the cannula is bent or damaged.
- 2. Do not use the pen needle if the shelf life is exceeded.

B. Caution

- 1. Always perform the injection at a 90° angle to the skin. Do not change the angle in order to prevent bending or breaking of the pen needle
- 2. Only use compatible pens with Autokeeper Safety Pen Needle.
- 3. Store the needles in a dry place at 1° up to 30°


Compatible Pens
